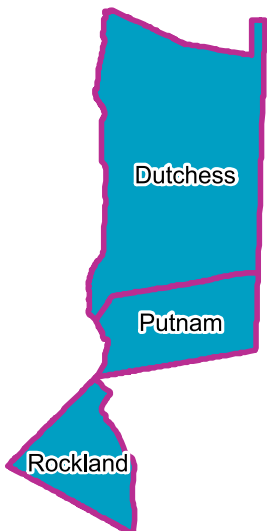




Peer Engagement Services

PEER ENGAGEMENT SERVICES by CAPE of Dutchess County

PEER ENGAGEMENT is a FREE service for Dutchess, Putnam and Rockland County residents (and their families) who are looking for support entering into, or maintaining long-term recovery from substance use disorder.

This service is provided by CAPE, the Council on Addiction Prevention and Education of Dutchess County, Inc.

CAPE is a contract agency of Dutchess County and is licensed by the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS).

HOW IT WORKS

We are **Peer Engagement Specialists** – people in long-term recovery from substance use disorder or addiction who understand what you are going through.

- We meet you out in the community: at a hospital, rehab facility, library, coffee shop, public park... wherever you are comfortable
- You're in recovery when you say you are; it is a judgement-free zone, no drug tests and no guilt
- We connect you with the resources YOU want and need – NOT necessarily what worked for us
- This process does not cost you anything or require any insurance, only your willingness to talk

WHO ARE PEER ENGAGEMENT SPECIALISTS?

We are people in long-term recovery from substance use disorder (SUD) or addiction, employed by CAPE, who understand what you are going through. We know your pain and the challenge of managing a chronic disease - one that carries a tremendous stigma.

*We also know the hope
and joy of recovery!*

CRISIS INTERVENTION

We want to help you or your loved one navigate through the detox/rehab process. If you are willing to seek further treatment, we will get you there and be by your side.

RESOURCES and SYSTEMS NAVIGATION

There are multiple pathways to recovery available. We can help you identify the pathway that will work best for you.
